JAPANESE ENCEPHALITIS VACCINATION FOR THE CHILDREN



The Tamil Nadu government launched a vaccination drive against Japanese Encephalitis (JE) in Vellore and other high-risk districts from August 2025 to November 2025. The initiative targeted children aged 1 to 15 years. At MBKG Pannai Home, a total of 103 children within this age group were vaccinated. The vaccinations were administered by nurses from the Serkadu Government Primary Health Centre under the supervision of Dr. Malarvizhi, the doctor in charge of the PHC.

MEDICINE AT PEOPLE'S DOORSTEP

(மக்களை தேழ மருத்துவம்)

The Tamil Nadu Government has launched a scheme for the health screening of people over 45 years old who have health issues. A medical team from the Government Primary Health Centre visits these individuals at their homes once every three months. During the visit, the team conducts health checks and prescribes necessary medications. This initiative is particularly beneficial for elderly grandmothers living at the Home, as it helps them adhere to their medication schedules.
